Notes:

- Students are to remain in their class the entire exam period. They may study for other exams if they finish early.
- Students who are still on campus at 11:45 must report to study hall.
- Bible classes, PE classes, junior high elective classes (with the exception of Spanish), and senior high fine arts classes will not have exams.
- A student who has a class that does not have an exam does not need to report to that class, **unless he is at school.**
- Students who owe fines will not be permitted in class for exams.
