GENERAL INFORMATION

SECURITY & DROP OFF

Security - It is our desire to ensure the safety of every camper here at Northside. For this reason, we ask that you **drop off** your camper in the following areas, making sure that he/she has checked in **before** you leave the property:

- Summer Day Camp - 6:30 - 8:30 - Majestic Forest / B-Wing Room 207 on Rainy Mornings. Please look for the flags posted at either entrance.
8:30 - 9:00 - Cafeteria for Snack

A Camp Counselor will be at the main gate of the Majestic Forest to check your camper in.

***Please make sure your camper has signed in with the counselor before going to play.

SECURITY - FLAG COLORS

Flags - Parents please look for the appropriate flag when dropping off or picking up your camper. Location flags may be posted outside of A-Wing, B-Wing, the Majestic Forest, Fine Arts Center, Main Gym, or AEL Pool. If you are unsure of your camper's location, please stop by the front desk at the Child Care Building.

FLAG COLORS

- GREEN - 1ST & 2ND GRADES
- BLUE - 3RD & 4TH GRADES
- ORANGE - 5TH, 6TH, & 7TH GRADES

SWIM DAY

ITEMS FROM HOME

Items from home - Northside Camp Kidz will not be responsible for any items your camper brings from home. Please make sure that everything is labeled if it is necessary to bring an item to camp. ELECTRONIC DEVICES, SUCH AS GAME BOYS, MP3 PLAYERS, CELL PHONES, ETC., ARE PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES AND WILL BE TAKEN FROM THE CAMPER AND RETURNED AT THE END OF THE DAY.

SCHEDULE CHANGES

Any changes that need to be made to a camper's schedule must be made by the Wednesday of the week BEFORE the needed change. Families with more than one child in Summer Camp will not be allowed to switch weeks between children. Each child needs to be registered individually.

DRESS CODE

Please keep in mind the following guidelines as you select your child's clothing for summer camp. The most important thing is to keep cool and comfortable in the hot weather we will experience!

GUYS:

1. Shorts are permitted.
2. A shirt must be worn at all times. Sleeveless shirts are acceptable. If slogan shirts are worn, please keep them to an athletic theme. Undershirts MAY NOT be worn as outerwear.
3. Tennis shoes are a MUST!! Sandals or Flip Flops may be worn on swim days only.
4. Hair should be neat and trimmed.

GIRLS:

1. Girls will be permitted to wear shorts that are fingertip length. They may wear slacks (blue jeans are acceptable), and skorts. No skirts please.
 2. Modest tank tops are acceptable. Please refrain from short or crop tops, tie shirts, and spaghetti straps.
 3. Girls will need a one-piece bathing suit or tankinie that covers her stomach.
 4. Tennis shoes are a MUST!! Sandals or Flip Flops may be worn on swim days only.
- Your child's counselor/director will determine immodest attire. Parents will be contacted to bring alternate clothing if needed.

CAMP T-SHIRTS

*******Camp T-Shirts are to be worn anytime campers leave Northside Property.** If an additional shirt must be given to your child to attend a field trip, your account will be charged for a new shirt. You may purchase an additional camp T-Shirt for field trips and keep the extra shirt in the car so you will always be prepared. Campers will not be permitted to leave campus without their T-Shirt.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

WE DO:

- We rely on positive reinforcement and praise. We want to catch your children doing well.
- We reward desirable behavior.
- We distract children from undesirable behavior by re-directing them to something more positive.
- We use time-out as a next step. The teacher will make sure that the child understands why he/she is being put in time out, then given time away from the group activity to calm down and reconsider their actions.
- We may, as a last resort, call you to come to the center to discipline your child within one hour.
- We deny the privilege of attending field trips and Camp Kidz to children who do not respond to the methods listed above.
- We rely heavily on contact with you, as a parent. If there is a behavior problem, we will contact you and ask for your assistance.

WE DO NOT:

- Spank or otherwise physically punish the children.
- Make fun of, yell at, or otherwise verbally abuse the children.
- Shame or punish the children when bathroom accidents occur.
- Deny meals or rest as punishment.
- Leave the children alone or without supervision.
- Allow discipline of children by other children or another child's parent.
- Criticize, make fun of, or otherwise belittle children's families or ethnic groups.

Snack / Lunch Policies & Procedures

Morning snacks will be provided each day. Your child will have a choice of milk or juice with the provided snack.

Lunch may be purchased in our cafeteria or you may bring a sack lunch from home.

Afternoon snacks will be provided each day. Your child may bring in additional snacks from home.

Debit System

Campers pay for their lunch in the cafeteria through the school's debit system. Parents must submit payment to the school cafeteria and request the money be added to their child's cafeteria account. Each camper is assigned a P.I.N. number. The camper will give the P.I.N. number to the cafeteria clerk and the lunch cost is debited from the camper's account. When a student's account becomes low on funds, a reminder is sent home to send more money for their child's account.

Lunch cost: \$3.50

Even if you plan for your child to bring his/her lunch each day, it is wise to put in enough money in the account for one day's lunch cost in the event your child forgets his/her lunch one day. Money will not be taken out of the account unless your child purchases a lunch from the cafeteria.

Below, you will find a suggested amount to deposit in your child's account for him/her to eat lunch each day during the summer:

***Lunches are not included in tuition payment. Lunch payments are made at NCA's Café.*

REGISTRATION: A \$75 non-refundable registration fee is to be submitted to the Business Office, along with completed application/session choices form to secure a space for your child. Spaces are limited and will be filled on a first-come basis. Late registrations will be processed, if space is available, providing registration is completed no later than Wednesday afternoon of the preceding week.

SESSION PRICES: Northside Summer Day Camp offers the flexibility of two session prices: \$100 for choosing a 1-3 day session, or \$155 for choosing a 4-5 day session.

PAYMENTS: Northside Camp Kidz tuition is due in advance each Monday for sessions chosen, or the first day attended that week. Tuition not paid by Friday incurs a \$5 per child late payment fee. Financial dismissal occurs when an account becomes two weeks delinquent. Northside parents may now view their family's accounting statement via the school's website, www.ncaknights.com and a link to RenWeb's ParentsWeb. Checks and money orders should be made payable to Northside Camp Kidz and placed in the Business Office drop box. Debit or credit card payments may be made at the Academy for Early Learning Reception Desk. We accept MasterCard, VISA, and Discover for credit and debit card payments. Lunches are *not included in tuition payment. Lunch payments are made at NCA's Café.*

HOURS: The Business Office is open from 7:45 a.m. until 3:45 p.m., Monday through Friday.

****CANCELLATION FEE:** *If you sign up for a session and your child will not be attending, e-mail or written cancellation must be provided to the Camp Office by the preceding Wednesday to avoid a \$45 cancellation fee.*

LATE PICK-UPS: Northside Camp Kidz closes promptly at 6:00 p.m. The late pick-up fee is \$15 per child for every 15 minutes thereafter.

RETURNED CHECKS: The fee for a returned check is \$29.00.

TAX REPORTING: We do not provide year-end summaries of dependent care expenses paid for tax reporting. You may print your family account record at the end of summer from RenWeb's ParentsWeb and keep for tax purposes. Our TAX I.D. No. is 56-0787452.

HOLIDAYS: Camp is closed Monday, May 31st for Memorial Day and Monday, July 5th for Independence Day. Fees are not reduced for these two weeks, unless your child chose a 1-3 day session for either of those weeks. The last day of Northside Camp Kidz is Friday, August 13, 2010.
